

Blue Squares Are Back!

You may have recently noticed some blue squares randomly placed on our streets. Those blue reflective squares are a visual signal to the fire department personnel as to the location of fire hydrants. The side of the center line in which they are located lets the fire department know which side of the street the hydrant is located so that they don't have to search. This makes for a quicker response time in an emergency.


